

## Exercise 8D

## Instructions:

1. Start a **New** file using either the **inch-helper.dwt** or the **metric-helper.dwt**  
The following exercise is designed to teach you how to insert text into the exact middle of a rectangular area using **Multiline Text**.
2. Draw a **6" [152.4 mm]** wide by **3" [76.2 mm]** high rectangle.
3. Select **"Multiline Text"**.
4. Start the text boundary box at the upper left corner (**P1**) of the rectangle. Place the opposite corner at the lower right corner (**P2**) of the rectangle. (Use **"Endpoint"** Object Snap to be accurate.)
5. Select Text Style Standard: **1" [25.4 mm]**, **Sans Serif** and **Middle Center**.
6. Type the word **Middle** and then select **Close Text Editor**.
7. **Save** the drawing as: **Ex-8D**
