

## Exercise 8E

### Instructions:

1. Start a **New** file using either the **inch-helper.dwt** or the **metric-helper.dwt**
2. Draw two **6" [152.4 mm]** long lines as shown.
3. Select **Single Line Text**.
  - A. Select **Justify - Center**.
  - B. Use "Midpoint" Snap to place the justification point at the midpoint of the line.
  - C. Use text height **1" [25.4 mm]** and rotation angle **0**.
  - D. Type the word **Happy** (use uppercase and lowercase) and then press **<Enter> <Enter>**.
4. Select **Single Line Text** again and type the same word on the second line but this time use **Justify - BC** (Bottom Center).

Notice the difference between Justify: **Center** and **Bottom Center**? "**Center**" only considers the uppercase letters when justifying. "**Bottom Center**" is concerned about those lowercase letters. Can you see how you could accidentally place your text too high or too low?

5. **Save** the drawing as: **Ex-8E**
